Remark

1. The minimum total credits required for graduation from the Department of Architecture and Interior Design are 134 credits for the four-year program (104 credits for required courses and 30 credits for electives in the Architecture Group; 106 credits for required courses and 28 credits for electives in the Interior Design Group).
2. If a student chooses to take courses from another department within the university, any credits earned that meet the course requirements of that program will be recognized as elective credits from outside the department, with a maximum of 21 credits accepted for each program completed.
3. For those who do not complete the program, according to the temporary curriculum committee and teaching meeting approved on July 4, 1995, up to 12 elective credits from outside the department are allowed.
4. Courses such as "Basic Design (I), (II)", "Interior Design (I), (II), (III), (IV), (V), (VI)", and "Architectural Design (I), (II), (III), (IV), (V), (VI)" are taught in groups and are prerequisite courses; students must complete the courses for one semester before they can continue to the next semester's courses.
